I am writing to advise you that our review of your complaint August 22, 2007 has been completed. After a thorough review of the allegations and research into the issues raised, all of the matters have been dismissed.

The conflict of interest issues have been resolved by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court in *Riverwalk Casino, L.P. v. Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, et al*, 926 A.2d 926 (Pa 2007). The remaining allegations have been dismissed either because there was no evidence of any violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct or because they were speculative, alleging only a possible violation at some time in the future.
